OUTLAWGER 8

GERMAN STYLE PILSNER

Local Option Bierwerker, Chicago, IL, United States, 5.00% ABV
Pours a brilliant yellow with a persistent head. Slightly hazy with playful carbonation adding to a fairly big mouthfeel. Notes of bread and biscuit are followed by expected peppery hop aromas for a classic German style.

EBEL’S WEISS 9

HEFEWEIZEN

Two Brothers Brewing, Warrenville, IL, United States, 4.90% ABV
Malty sweetness with soft aromas of classic wheat beer and aromatics of clove, vanilla and bananas. Hazy orange, unfiltered glow sits under an off-white, pillowy head.

SAISON / FARMHOUSE ALE

Boulevard Brewing Co., Kansas City, MO, United States, 8.50% ABV
Begins with hints of citrus and intense hop aromas and finishes lightly with grapefruit-tangerine. Golden orange hue with a soft head and tight lacing.

LAGUNITAS IPA 7

AMERICAN IPA

Lagunitas Brewing Co., Chicago, IL, United States, 6.20% ABV
This California classic is now made in Chicago. Great ale plus better water means an even better beer.

ALPHA KING 9

AMERICAN PALE ALE

Three Floyd’s Brewing Co.; Munster, IN, US, 6.66% ABV
The flagship beer from this Midwest craft brewing giant. A bold yet balanced ale with slight caramel sweetness and bold citrus hoppiness.

MATILDA 12

BELGIAN STRONG PALE ALE

Goose Island Beer Co., Chicago, IL, United States, 7.00% ABV
Baking-spice and musk aromas are clear from the barrel aging. Tart fruits and green apple skin flavors are softened by the biscuit malt flavor and an off-dry body. Pours a foggy copper with light amber at the edges.

NITRO OATMEAL STOUT 8

OATMEAL STOUT

Founders Brewing Co., Grand Rapids, MI, United States, 4.50% ABV
Pours a murky coffee brown via a nitro-blended draw that settles into a dark onyx. Mild roasted vanilla malts and cocoa are clear on the nose as well as the palate. Straightforward stout with a velvety mouthfeel and classic “gulpability”.

- STELLA ARTOIS** 7
EUROPEAN PALE LAGER
Den Hoorn Brewery, Lueven, Belgium, 5.00% ABV
A nice gold/yellow color. Light, yeasty bread notes, some grass and very slight note of fruit. Light-bodied, crisp and classic.
- TWENTY PLUS PILS (CAN)** 7
GERMAN STYLE PILSNER
Two Brothers Brewing, Warrenville, IL, United States, 4.80% ABV
A beer that seems so simple actually took 20 years to perfect. Citrusy and lightly hopped, this is a thirst quencher that deserves to be recognized as something more than a simple yellow beer.
- PILSNER URQUELL (16 OZ CAN)** 7
CZECH PILSNER
Plzeňský Prazdroj, Plzeň, Czech Republic, 4.40% ABV
An import lager that is truly better out of the can. The slight hoppiness brings out the grassy undertones, and the finish is crisp and clean. A deep gold color when poured, with a light, foamy head. No bitter beer face here.
- PILS** 8
CZECH STYLE PILSNER
Lagunitas Brewing Co., Petaluma, CA, United States, 6.2% ABV
A quality Czech style pilsner from this iconic, Californian craft brewery that has recently opened a satellite here in Chicago. Smooth drinking with more carbonation than most pilsners and a clean finish. A beer that would make Anton Cermak proud.
- BUDWEISER** 6
AMERICAN LAGER
Anheuser-Busch, St. Louis, MO, United States, 5.00% ABV
Brewed using a blend of imported and American hops and a most palatable balance of barley malts and rice, this crisp lager is brewed with time-honored methods and signature Beechwood aging.
- CORONA EXTRA** 7
AMERICAN LAGER
Grupo Modelo S.A. de C.V., Mexico City, Mexico, 4.60% ABV
Sparkling clear golden hue, sweet grass and corn on the vapor that brightens with a squeeze of lime. Uber light-bodied and intended as a session beer over hot months and social outings. A signature lawnmower style—simple but refreshing.
- BUD LIGHT** 6
LIGHT LAGER
Anheuser-Busch, St. Louis, MO, United States, 4.20% ABV
Brewed using a blend of aroma hop varieties and a combination of barley malts and rice. Its drinkability and refreshing flavor make it a favorite light beer for many.
- MILLER LITE** 6
LIGHT LAGER
Miller Brewing Co., Milwaukee, WI, United States, 4.17% ABV
Tastes great. Less filling.
- COORS LIGHT** 6
LIGHT LAGER
Coors Brewing Company, Golden, CO, United States, 4.20% ABV
Crystal-clear, very light yellow in color. Pours a thin, bright white head that might diminish quickly. Very active carbonation and mouthfeel. Light citrus aroma and slight earthy taste. A hint of corn comes through. Best when ice cold.



ALES, PORTERS & STOUTS

- DUVEL** 11
BELGIAN BLONDE ALE
Duvel Moortgat, Breendonk, Belgium, 8.50% ABV
Blonde in color, slightly fruity with a dry aroma and slightly bitter finish. The ale is well hopped with exclusive Slovenian and German hops and brewed naturally since 1871.
- GONEAWAY** 10
INDIA PALE ALE
Half Acre Beer Company, Chicago, IL, United States, 6.70% ABV
It is everything you are looking for in a traditional, American-made IPA.
- ALLAGASH WHITE ALE** 8
BELGIAN STYLE WHEAT ALE
Allagash Brewing Co., Portland, ME, United States, 5.0% ABV
Light gold and cloudy, this representation of a Belgian white ale is brewed with coriander and orange peel. A rich body with a tall, dense head, this ale is aromatic and refreshing.
- APEX PREDATOR** 10
SAISON/FARMHOUSE ALE
Off Color Brewing, Chicago, IL, United States, 6.80% ABV
As pretty to look at as it is to drink, this farmhouse style ale has a hazy golden body, a rich, frothy head and aromas and flavors of citrus and light hops. Albeit light, the texture is still quite silky.
- DISTORTER** 9
PORTER
Greenbush Brewing Co., Sawyer, MI United States, 7.20% ABV
Deep, dense and dark, this beer is part Porter and part Stout, with roasted coffee and cocoa aromas, flavors and rich mouthfeel.
- GUINNESS PUB CAN** 8
IRISH DRY STOUT
Guinness LTD., St. James's Gate, Dublin, Ireland, 5.40% ABV
This stout is “charged” by an internal nitro-widgit as it is poured. A rich, creamy off-white head falls through itself above a super dark brown body, roasted malt aromas, earthy hops and notes of coffee and cocoa; slightly bitter dry finish.
- DRAGON'S MILK** 17
BARREL-AGED IMPERIAL STOUT
New Holland Brewing Co., Holland, MI, United States, 11% ABV
A barrel-aged Imperial Stout with roasty malt character intermingled with deep vanilla tones, all dancing in an oak bath. A rich and heavy brew for cold weather and contemplation.
- BBQ BOURBON BARREL AGED QUADRUPEL** 15
Boulevard Brewing Co., Kansas City, MO, US, 11.8% ABV
This abbey style quadruple is aged for varying lengths in Bourbon barrels and then topped off with cherries. The result is a rich, mellow, yet full abbey ale with toffee, vanilla, and cherry aromatics. It also pairs wonderfully with BBQ. Amazing how that works out.

Bulmers Limited, Clonmel, Tipperary County, Ireland, 4.5% ABV
Seventeen varieties of ripe apples are fermented for up to two years while a secondary malolactic fermentation balances the cider to pour a peachy-gold color, with unmistakable taste of farm barrels and a touch of dry white peach.
